



SOLID OAK CARE

RJ Living solid Oak furniture is coated with a hardwax oil, which allows the natural beauty of solid Oak to shine through, while also offering a layer of protection against substances and liquids. It is important to regularly care for your furniture piece to ensure it stays in perfect condition.

Dust your furniture piece with a soft lint free clean dry cloth/duster, ensuring there is no grit contained within the cloth/duster.

Avoid placing hot objects directly on the timber surface; always use coasters/ place mats where possible.

For any spillages on the timber surface, wipe immediately with a soft, slightly damp cloth in the direction of the wood grain. If sticky liquid residue remains, remove it with a diluted solution of warm soapy water, followed by a clean damp sponge. This area should then be wiped immediately in the direction of the wood grain with a clean, soft white cloth until completely dry.

Across the lifetime of your piece, the timber tone will vary slightly due to the effects of natural light, which is a common part of the ageing process of solid wood. Avoid exposure to direct sunlight for prolonged periods of time, as this can cause discolouring. Also ensure that any objects placed on the timber surface are periodically re-arranged to allow an even ageing process.

Renewing the Osmo coating on your furniture piece is recommended on a yearly basis to maintain its natural timber tone and protective barrier against stains. Using fine sandpaper, lightly sand the timber surface in the direction of the wood grain, which will remove the existing coating. Then apply Osmo 3044 raw transparent oil (sold at hardware stores) with a light cloth to re coat the surface.
